“Grant Lock directed Afghanistan’s largest eye care program. Until he **himself** became blind. He returns home to a society with its own blind spots: myopic attitudes to Islam, mental health and what makes us human. After battling corruption,

injustice and disadvantage in the deserts, mountains and cities of Pakistan and Afghanistan, Lock confronts challenges—both intimate and global—with courage and compassion”.

“Getting a grip on Islam and Relating to Our Aussie Muslims.”

Grant and Janna Lock spent 24 years in Pakistan and Afghanistan, supporting micro-hydroelectric systems, empowering Afghan widows and overseeing a massive eye-care program. **Grant and Janna Lock are speaking at Trinity Lutheran church on Sunday 14 July at 8am and 10am services.**

LCA International Mission News

LCA International Mission are supporting **Anke and Patrick Sprau**, who have signed up for service in Papua New Guinea (PNG) and are currently waiting for their visas and Patrick's dual citizenship as well as their funding to be complete. Once the Sprau family have reached their financial quota, they will be able to notify the PNG branch that they are ready to go. They are only able to book their tickets once they reach 90% of their support and will only be able to leave for the mission field once they reach 100%.

LCA International Mission are also supporting **Ian Hutchinson**. Ian spent 4 years with Wycliffe Bible Translators in Papua New Guinea (PNG) from 1980-84, hiking around the Eastern Highlands Province, supervising literacy programs in several languages, helping children learn to read the Scriptures in their village language. In October 2018, he returned to Papua New Guinea with Wycliffe Bible Translators, this time as the Highlands Audio Project Manager, to help put translated Scriptures onto solar powered AudioBibles and SD cards, so that the word can be heard.

Through your support of Anke, Patrick and their family and Ian with prayer, sending them an encouraging email, reading their stories and telling others of what God is doing, or making a donation, you can be the instrument of the movement of God's love within Australia and also beyond our borders.
