



Peace Lutheran College will be the venue for the 2025 Queensland District Pastor's Conference on the 27th and 28th of May this year. The theme for this year's Pastor's Conference is "*Refined in Faith, Strengthened by Fire*".

Following the Pastor's Conference, the LCAQD Convention of Synod is programmed to take place from 30th May to 01 June 2025. Pastor David is our main point of contact for the District Office.

The LCAQD's web site shares the following regarding the Synod.

"At our annual Convention of the Synod, delegates and visitors gather to celebrate who we are and where we've been in the past year. As the agencies of the Lutheran Church Queensland District, we gather together to discern, through prayer and conversation, where God may be leading us in the years ahead. So while it is our District's Annual general Meeting, the opportunity to worship together and to connect over food and conversation is just as important for the health of the LCAQD as the business decisions."
