

## Retiring Offering – August – MAF International



The congregation voted to support three charitable causes during 2025 and on the 3<sup>rd</sup> August we will have a retiring offering for MAF International.

Mission Aviation Fellowship is an international Christian organisation whose purpose is to bring help, hope and healing through aviation to people living in isolation and poverty.

Every 5.6 minutes a MAF aircraft takes off or lands somewhere in the world, transporting people who live in remote villages and assisting missions, churches, aid and development agencies and others working to transform the lives of communities that are cut off from the outside world.

Through our retiring offering, we ask that you consider supporting the great work that MAF does around the globe.

## Council News

As mentioned in our June Bulletin, the Council has submitted an application for a grant. If we are successful, we hope to re-upholster the existing pews and re-carpet the church.

The re-upholstery work builds on planning that commenced in 2022 and is based on fabric and colour selections made at that time. We will however have the opportunity within the fabric range to select a different colour if that works better for us. Other than selecting the range to apply to the carpet, no effort has been made to choose colours as yet.

The grant closed on 18<sup>th</sup> July. We are hoping to hear about whether we have been successful in the next few weeks. Being in an optimistic mindset, if you have an interest in ensuring that the colour selection of both the fabric for the pews and the carpet colour selection continue to serve our congregation into the future, let Jo-Anne know and she will make sure you get your say.
