Congregation and Parish News

The Trinity Congregation held a Special Meeting on 16th November that saw unanimous support to proceed with a call for a Pastor. The meeting also flagged that the question of expanding the Parish would **be deferred to the upcoming AGM** in February to enable due diligence to proceed.

At the meeting, the Trinity congregation nominated our representatives for the Call Committee. The Call Committee comprises - Roger Strickland (Parish chairperson), Michael Fraser (Trinity



Chairperson), Martin Klink (Pastoral Assistant), Lynalee Strickland (Our Saviour Chairperson), Kathy Tidmarsh (Our Saviour Secretary) with Pastor David Spanagel taking an advisory role. Pastor David Schmidt, Assistant Bishop for Mission, who was visiting us on 16th November, is providing process guidance.

The Call Committee have now met and a Parish Meeting has been called for Sunday 30th November (following services at Trinity Lutheran Church, to formally consider the request to the College of Bishops to assign a Pastor to our congregation. Members of the congregation are asked to make attendance at this meeting your priority.

The due diligence on the expanded Parish is progressing well and a number of practicalities have been explored but further discussion is required to settle how the expanded Parish would be appropriately served. Exploration of options will continue and you are invited to engage in these discussions with Pastor David Spanagel or any members of your congregation or Parish Councils.

News from around the region

As usual, Pastor David has been very busy in service of many across the far North.

Hope Vale

Recently a lease was signed with Empowering Connections & Support Services (an arm of NDIS) to lease half of the Hope Vale Church hall providing a very significant income for the congregation and an equally important service to the town.

The 'Op Shop' has been relocated to a larger premise. This is run for community people and again provides a very significant income stream apart from a service to the community and also a ministry opportunity including an avenue for mental health therapy simply by visting, browsing or a down to earth 'chat'. It was great to hear of the Trinity congregation's plans to support this ministry.

To support the community ministry we have established a connection with ECLS (Empowering Connections & Support Services an arm of NDIS) operating from the church hall who enthusiastically welcomed the addition of Bible Story books, devotion books and Bibles to their office for clients to take away at no cost. This is a very significant way of reaching into the community with a meaningful God based message. The leader of the group, Chrissy, is pictured below and young Chloe couldn't resist being in on the picture.





As word has gotten around, this same ministry material has proven to be in high demand and is also now available in the:

- Hope Vale Wellbeing Centre for their clients and staff. This is generally a men's health organization run by Apunipima a Cape York Aboriginal health organization.
- Hope Vale Community Care Office where we meet with those who are generally 'homebound'
 for a communion and fellowship hour each month. This group is expanding rapidly with word
 getting around that not only home bound people are welcome. We recently had a group of 29
 people across an age range 20- 90!! This is inspirational.
- The local school also welcomed the addition of these same books into their staff library and 'Time Out' room.
- The Hope Vale Day Care Centre did not want to miss out either!! They heard about this and approached us to see if they could also have some of these resources available for their children with the idea of sending a 'gift' home with each child. God is so Good!

These initiatives have been made possible through the generosity of members within the LCAQD who have responded to our invitation to send these resources to us in NQ.

Coen

Coen is a small town of around 300 people 500-600kms north of Cairns. Our church has been active in this community since Rev George Rosendale's time in the 1960's -70's. The Lutheran influence was again strengthened with the opening of Peace Lutheran College in 1994 as a number of students from Coen have attended over the years and consider themselves Lutheran. In more recent times our visits have been very irregular, however through regular telephone contact many still 'want to be

Lutheran'. Although small and distant this is a challenge to be faced now and into the future by our church.

After a 12 month hiatus we have now resumed services at Wujal Wujal. There has been numerous challenges but the community continue to support the presence of the Church. This image shows a small group the people who are keen to move forward. On 24th October one of our beloved church members left us for heavenly glory. We will all miss her in so many ways. While there are many challenges, there is a majority of people who really value the work of the church and in their own quiet way support this through opportunities as they are presented.


