

News from around the region

As usual, Pastor David has been very busy in the service of many across the far North.

Coen

Coen is a small town of around 300 people 500-600kms north of Cairns. Our church has been active in this community since Rev George Rosendale's time in the 1960's – 70's. The Lutheran influence was again strengthened with the opening of Peace Lutheran College in 1994 as a number of students from Coen have attended over the years and consider themselves Lutheran.

In more recent times our visits have been very irregular, however through telephone contact many still 'want to be Lutheran'. Although small and distant this is a challenge to be faced now and into the future by our church. Probably the simple question is how much value do we place on a Soul?

Do we continue to travel 7 hours from Cairns for Baptisms/Funerals. We generally cover these expenses through the sale of pre loved goods not available anywhere else. This service compliments the ministry we are doing here. We've been told over again 'we want spiritual care but we also have a need for physical support not available anywhere else in our town'.

On Sunday 23rd November we had the Baptisms of twins Azalea and Scott-Lynn Spratt-Upton. A most joyful occasion with a cross section of 49 town/congregation members in attendance.
